Common tenancy with rights to survivors: This is similar to tenancy law jointly. The main difference is that if one of the joint tenants dies, the remaining tenants acquire the deceased's interest. A single survivor becomes the sole owner. Tenancy throughout: Married couples have the possibility of tenancy throughout. In this case, the law treats the couple as a single entity, and each individual is entitled to 100 percent of the interest.
